The virtual machines move dynamically between the physical hosts and run a variety of workloads to support the company. On average, there are more than 10 virtual machines running on a physical host simultaneously.

Lucerne Publishing uses Microsoft SQL Server 2008, SQL Server 2012, and SQL Server 2016 to support its line-of-business applications and other key products.

Lucerne Publishing uses Microsoft SharePoint Server 2016 to host the company's intranet, to which all employees have access, as well as the company's customer –facing website. Internal and external communications are delivered by using Microsoft Exchange Server 2016 and Microsoft Skype for Business Server 2015.
