#### **QUESTION NO: 4**

**QUESTION NO: 7**

A client will be using AEM Forms components to build out their enterprise applications. The client wants to record analytics from their library of forms that will be used, and they have security concerns and organizational policies that require that any collected data is stored on-premise and not by any third parties, such as Adobe. The client would also like to enable mutual authentication between AEM Forms and Analytics to ensure the security and integrity of the collected data.

What architectural consideration must be made?

- A. The client will NO longer be able to use Analytics' reporting tools, as they exist only in the cloud.
- B. A local instance of Adobe Analytics will need to be configured to accept data from the cloud.
- C. A local data store will need to be provisioned that can be accessed directly by Analytics.
